



## US approves \$3bn sustainment package for Saudi F-15 fleet

The US State Department has approved the possible Foreign Military Sale (FMS) to Saudi Arabia of equipment and support services related to the ongoing sustainment of the nation's extensive fleet of Boeing F-15 Eagle fighters for an estimated cost of \$3bn.

Approval of this prospective FMS was announced by the US Defense Security Cooperation Agency (DSCA) – which handles most of Washington's impending military export sales – after it had notified US Congress of the proposed multi-billion deal on 3 February. While Saudi Arabia has not requested the purchase of any new aircraft, the nation has requested

the purchase of relevant equipment and services to support the ongoing sustainment and operation of its existing fleet of legacy F-15C/Ds and newer F-15S/SA jets.

In confirming that this deal had been given an initial green light, the DSCA said: "This proposed sale will support the foreign policy and national security objectives of the [US] by improving the security of a major non-NATO ally that is a force for political stability and economic progress in the Gulf region." ## South Korea's Slam Eagles set for \$2.8 billion F-15EX standard upgrade from Boeing

South Korea's F-15K "Slam Eagles" have been cleared for a massive over-decade-long upgrade. This will upgrade the jets to the modern F-15EX standard currently being purchased by the USAF and mirrors Japan's efforts to upgrade F-15Js to the F-15JSI (Japan Super Interceptor) standard. US approves upgrading South Korea's F-15K Slam Eagle fighter jets On 31st January, the US Department of War announced it has awarded a \$2.8 billion "hybrid cost-plus-fixed-fee and fixed-priced incentive undefinitized contract for F-15K 'Slam Eagle' Republic of Korea aircraft upgrades."

The US Department of Defence (DoD) contracted a Belgian engineering company, Sabena Aerospace, to conduct engine maintenance and material management for Europe's legacy F-16s due to enter service in the Ukrainian Air Force. 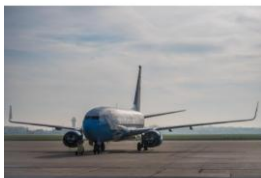

« Le gain opérationnel apporté par le F3 se traduit par un panel de nouvelles missions réalisables par ces avions : attaque air-sol et reconnaissance, mais aussi possibilité d'assurer la mission de dissuasion nucléaire. », explique Christophe Carpentier, responsable technique de l'opération « Retrofit F1-F3 » à la Direction générale de l'armement (DGA). Selon lui, un des challenges du projet est la maîtrise des événements clés, comme l'entrée d'un avion en retrofit ou la sortie d'un fuselage du Service Industriel de l'aéronautique (SIA4).

BAE Systems is competing against Lockheed Martin to be the prime contractor for Korea's forthcoming upgrade of some 130 F-16s. But the Korean request for proposals also invited non-OEMs to bid as system integrator.

The company designed and has installed a new commercial fire control computer (CFCC) in 270 U.S. Air National Guard F-16CD...
